

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ST. JOSEPH CEMETERY**

1. All decorations must be placed on the monument or on the foundation.
2. All winter flowers must be removed by April 15.
3. Summer decorations must be removed by October 15.
4. Bouquets and tripods may be placed for Memorial Day, but must be removed after 14 days.
5. One shepherds hook allowed per grave and must be secured in the footing only.
6. The cemetery reserves the right to remove all objects of any kind that would interfere with mowing and trimming of grass.
7. No eternal lights.
8. No benches, stools or items of any kind can be placed beyond foundation.
9. Statues must be fastened on base of monument
10. No permanent planting will be permitted on any lot.
11. Bench-type monuments (instead of uprights) are permitted when placed on base approved by cemetery board.
12. All graves sold will be marked with a permanent marker within one year after burial occurs.
13. \$100 administration fee for each burial.
14. Two cremains can be buried in 1 grave. Cremains cannot be buried on top of or beside occupied grave.
15. All graves are opened and closed by contractor for St. Joseph Cemetery; no other opening or closing of graves is permitted.
16. St. Joseph Cemetery Board reserves the right to remove any decorations not meeting above requirements or decorations that become unsightly.
