

ST. BONIFACE MONUMENT REGULATIONS

All headstones must be cleared through the St. Boniface Church office. Call Pat Engleken at 563-451-6475 or Wayne Brunsman at 563-599-2675. prior to ordering and placement of the stone at St. Boniface Cemetery.

ST. BONIFACE CEMETERY REGULATIONS

1. Flowers, shrubs and trees may NOT be planted in the cemetery. Please no rocks, balloons, golf balls as weights in your flower pots. Often they tip onto the lawn and create a hazard for the lawn mowers. Military and state flags only.
2. Shepherd hooks are to be in the cement foundation, only 1 per grave and no more than 3 feet (36 inches) tall.
3. Solar lights cannot be attached to the monument in any way. Only allowed on base and foundation.
4. Flags, metal stakes, shepherd hooks and solar lights not in the foundation:
 - a. Anything that would impair proper maintenance of the cemetery will need to be removed by November 9, 2015. All metal stakes and/or shepherd hooks for flags, flower pots, etc. need to be removed. Items not removed by the above date will be disposed of.
 - b. Flags, metal stakes, shepherd hooks and solar lights will only be allowed to be placed around the graves during 6 major holidays - Easter, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, All Souls and Christmas.
5. Imitation flowers, wreaths and tripods to hold flowers should be removed within two weeks following the 6 major holidays.
6. Flowers left over a longer period of time must be firmly attached to the tombstones so as not to interfere with maintaining the cemetery.
7. Pets must be kept on a leash. Owners responsible for cleanup. 8. Please drive on hard surfaced driveways only. Please do not drive on the lawns.
