

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ST. JOSEPH CEMETERY

1. All winter flowers must be removed by April 15 unless on the monument.
2. The cemetery reserves the right to dispose of any flowers, natural or artificial, if not fastened on base or on monument, if they become unsightly after April 15.
3. The cemetery reserves the right to remove all objects of any kind that would interfere with mowing and trimming of grass.
4. No eternal lights.
5. No benches, stools or items of any kind.
6. Statues must be fastened on base of monument
7. Bouquets and tripods may be placed for Memorial Day, but must be removed after 7 days.
8. All graves are opened and closed by contractor for St. Joseph Cemetery; no other opening or closing of graves is permitted.
9. No base or monument work done on cemetery in spring until ground is fit; check with custodian.
10. All lots are to be paid for before any burial or any monument can be placed.
11. Installation of base must be approved by board.
12. Foundations may be extended 15 inches on each side of monument for placing of pots or urns for flowers.
13. No permanent planting will be permitted on any lot.
14. Bench-type monuments (instead of uprights) are permitted when placed on base approved by cemetery board.
15. All graves sold will be marked with a permanent marker within one year after burial occurs.
16. Open/Closing fee will be \$75 administration fee plus the cost of digging.
17. Two cremains can be buried in 1 grave. Cremains cannot be buried on top of or beside occupied grave.
